



## The grant administration lifecycle for the Capital Grants Program includes six key stages

The grant administration lifecycle provides a framework to understand the end-to-end process for grants administration. The following sections are structured against each stage of the lifecycle, but adapted and applied to the Capital Grants Program and its individual grant programs.



- 1 The **STRATEGY** stage involves defining agreed strategic outcomes, and linking the Capital Grants Program and individual grant program objectives to the broader strategic framework using program logics.
- 2 The **DEVELOP** stage involves establishing the core features of new individual grant programs including setting out eligibility and assessment criteria.
- 3 The **COMMUNICATE** stage defines the processes for promoting the Capital Grants Program and individual grant programs and working collaboratively with grant customers where appropriate.
- 4 The **ASSESS, AWARD AND EXECUTE** stage establishes the processes required for assessing and awarding grant applications, as well as negotiating and executing grant agreements.
- 5 The **MANAGE AND DELIVER** stage defines the processes for managing, monitoring, varying and acquitting grants.
- 6 The **EVALUATE** stage establishes the processes for evaluating the overall Capital Grants Program and individual grant program outcomes.
