




COLD CASE INVESTIGATION APPEAL

TERENCE JOHN FISHER



WA Police Force is seeking information regarding Terence John Fisher who has been identified as a suspect in the 1979 murder of 22-year-old Kerryn Mary Tate. Fisher was born in Mt Lawley on 11 February 1950 and died of natural causes on 27 August 2000. He served in the Australian Army between 1970 and 1972, married in 1973 and separated in 1981. Fisher was living in Rivervale and Manning at the time of Kerryn's murder – December 1979, and he lived in Manning from 1981 until his death. Fisher was a carpenter by trade and worked for the Public Works Department until 1993, at which point he was self-employed. He was an avid sailor and a prominent member of the Fremantle Sailing Club, and is believed to have attended liquor establishments in the Carlisle, Victoria Park and Manning areas.
