



CRTAFE WA Firearms Safety Training Course - Theory Q&A

The CRTAFE Firearms Safety Training Course - Theory package consists of the course material and an assessment. It is an on-line course completed via Central Regional TAFE (CRTAFE).

Frequently asked questions and answers

Q. Who is required to complete Firearms Training?

A. It is mandatory for all new firearms authority applicants and authorised persons.

Q. What part of the application process is the training?

A. The training course is required to be completed prior to submitting a firearms licence application. Upon successful completion of the course, the applicant will receive a certificate from CRTAFE that will be required as part of the firearm licence application.

Q. What is the practical training package made up of?

A. The CRTAFE Theory Training package consists of the course material and an assessment. The course provides comprehensive information on essential topics, including, firearm laws, safety and storage practices. The course is followed by assessment.

Q. What is the assessment made up of?

A. The course assessment comprises of 40 questions, which are randomly selected from a question bank. Each attempt will contain different questions.

Q. What is the pass mark?

A. To successfully pass the course assessment, applicants must achieve an overall score of at least 80% across the three sections.

Q. How long should I dedicate to completing the theory training package?

A. Allow around 2 hours to complete the course and assessment questions.

Q. How many attempts can I have to pass the assessment questions?

A. The applicant will have 3 attempts to pass the assessment. If the applicant does not pass the assessment questions within 3 attempts, the applicant must wait at least 30 days from the day of the last attempt before re-enrolling for additional attempts. The applicant will be required to pay a further Enrolment Fee.

Q. How long is the certificate valid for when applying for a firearms licence?

A. The CRTAFE certificate is valid for 12 months.

Q. Where do I go to enrol?

Q. How long does enrolment take?

A. Once enrolment is completed, it is possible that it may take up to 6 hours for the systems security to do their checks.

Q. What happens once I enrol – how long will I have to complete the training course?

A. The applicant will have 3 months from date of enrolment to complete the training course.

Q. How much does it cost?

A. The enrolment fee is set by CRTAFE WA and can be found on their website.
