Regarding the proposed legislation for embedded networks there are a number of items that you have mentioned which I would like to comment on

- Sub-Meter boxes must be easily available, and readable to each household, preferably attached to the house if possible.
- We need to check electrical usage of new purchases to better manage our budgets.
- Contested recording can be reviewed readily and quickly resolved.
- Solar meters and submeters should provide input and output clearly to provide clarity.
- Owners supply charge fees should clearly state what those fees provide . Noting that Synergy states maintenance, meter reading and also laying underground lines and power poles, more clarity on these fees is needed as there is a 192% increase in April.
