

Aboriginal Family Safety Grants

Applications open in May 2024

If you're an Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisation or Registered Aboriginal Business, you can apply for grant funding to prevent or respond to family violence in your community.

What are the aims of the grants?

To fund projects that contribute to:

- New and innovative Aboriginal and community-led family safety initiatives that prevent or respond to family violence
- Local, place-based and Aboriginal-led solutions and actions to address family violence.

Who can apply?

- Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations
- · Registered Aboriginal Businesses.

What can you apply for?

- Two years of funding for delivery of a family safety program or initiative in your local community, and
- Activities to build capacity and help deliver your initiative (e.g. training, project support, community engagement).

How much can you apply for?

Applicants can apply for up to \$500,000 over two years.

When can you apply?

You can submit your grant applications on Tenders WA from mid-May 2024. Further information will be provided in due course.
