## INFORMATION SHEET PAINTBALL LICENCE



### **Paintball Licence**

#### Purpose (s.42 Firearms Act 2024)

A Paintball Licence authorises the licensee to use a prescribed paintball gun for the purposes of participating in games of paintball conducted under the authority of a Paintball Business Licence.

A prescribed paintball gun is limited to use with prescribed paintball pellets.

#### Licensed Paintball Business Letter (r.42 Firearms Regulations 2024)

An application for the grant of a Paintball Licence must include a letter from a licensee of a Paintball Business Licence that confirms that the applicant has participated in at least **3** paintball games conducted under the authority of the Paintball Business Licence within the last **6** months.

This means you must be a member of a Licensed Paintball Club and have participated in at least 3 games of paintball at the club in the 6 months prior to applying for your Paintball Licence.

## No use other than at a licensed premises (*r.43, r.70 Firearms Regulations 2024*)

A Paintball Licence does not authorise the use of a prescribed paintball gun to which the licence applies other than at licensed premises for a Paintball Business Licence.

# Prescribed paintball gun (*s.5 Firearms Act 2024, r.8 Firearms Regulations 2024*)

The paintball gun must:

- Have a calibre of at least 0.4 inches and not more than 0.68 inches; and
- Have a barrel length of at least 120mm; and
- Be a single shot gun, pump action gun or self-loading gun; and
- Have a hopper to store paintball pellets that is attached externally to the gun; and
- Have a pistol grip or stock; and
- Have a foregrip.

The paintball gun must not:

 Be capable of firing a paintball pellet at a velocity of more than 91.44 metres per second; or

- Have the appearance of:
  - A handgun; or
  - A firearm specified in Schedule 2 Division 1.

### Prescribed paintball pellet (s.5 Firearms Act 2024, r.9 Firearms Regulations 2024)

The paintball pellet must:

- Be in the form of a gelatine capsule; **and**
- Have a diameter of at least 10mm and no more than 17.27mm; and
- Be filled with a water-soluble marking dye of any colour except red or brown.
