Re: Improving access to, and operation of, the Pilbara electricity network – The North West Interconnected System Issues Paper (issues paper)

The Pilbara Development Commission (Commission) is pleased to see the 'issues paper' released as a positive step to drive reform in the Pilbara, that will potentially have real benefit to the region, its communities and businesses. The issues paper is looking to deliver increased efficiency for the electricity industry and as this should result in reduced costs to consumers, and increased access to the grid to new users and producer. The Commission supports the focus on regulatory reform for the electricity industry in the region.
