



Rule Change Extension Notice: Reduced Frequency of Determining the Energy Price Limits and Maximum Reserve Capacity Price (RC_2014_05)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the Wholesale Electricity Market Rules (Market Rules).

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the IMO has extended the timeframe for the publication for the Draft Rule Change Report for the Rule Change Proposal: Reduced Frequency of Determining the Energy Price Limits and Maximum Reserve Capacity Price (RC_2014_05) by 25 Business Days until **Thursday 30 April 2015**.

Dates for subsequent steps of the rule change process have been adjusted accordingly.

Reason for the extension

The timeframe has been further extended to allow the IMO to consider the outcomes of the State Government's Electricity Market Review and any potential impacts on this Rule Change Proposal.

Proposed work program


- The IMO presents its draft decision in the Draft Rule Change Report.

- If approved, the Amending Rules commence.
