

Rule Change Extension Notice: The Relevant Demand calculation (RC_2019_01)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the WEM Rules.

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the WEM Rules, the Rule Change Panel has extended the timeframe for the publication of the Draft Rule Change Report for the Rule Change Proposal titled “The Relevant Demand calculation” (RC_2019_01) until **5:00 PM on Friday 31 December 2021**.

Dates for subsequent steps of the rule change process have been adjusted accordingly.

Reason for the Extension

The Rule Change Panel was unable to progress this Rule Change Proposal due to competing priorities.

The Rule Change Panel notes that responsibility for administration of the WEM Rules will be transferred from the Rule Change Panel to the Coordinator of Energy (**Coordinator**) on 1 July 2021, so the Coordinator will be responsible for progressing the Rule Change Proposal from that date.

The Rule Change Panel has extended the timeframe for the publication of the Draft Rule Change Report until 31 December 2021 to give the Coordinator sufficient time to perform the analysis and prepare the Draft Rule Change Report while managing competing priorities.
