Meeting summary

At the second meeting:

- The Chair welcomed members including new membership from the Department of Health.
- A revised Code of Conduct was endorsed.
- A presentation from the Department of Health was provided, covering the infection, patient/consumer safety needs and COVID-19 considerations for plastic straws.
 Health implications will be considered in future discussions.
- The working group received a presentation on feedback provided by members following meeting one. Responses identified the impacts, opportunities, barriers and accessibility and environmental considerations for a phase-out of plastic straws.
 Feedback will inform discussions to ensure appropriate exemptions are introduced as part of phasing out plastic straws.
- A presentation was provided by the South Australian Government on their approach to developing regulatory exemptions in their legislation to ensure ongoing access for those requiring plastic straws on 1 March 2021.
- Working group members were asked to seek feedback and input from their members
 on the suitability of South Australia's exemptions being applied in Western
 Australia's regulations. Responses will be discussed at the third working group
 meeting.
- Working group members were requested to review materials for a community survey investigating plastic straw consumption behaviours and barriers to change. Results will be presented to the working group in future meetings.

The next meeting is scheduled for 18 May 2021.
