KALBARRI BLUE HOLES FISH HABITAT PROTECTION AREA ORDER 2007

FD 355/04 [823]

Made by the Minister under section 115.

1. Citation

This order is the *Kalbarri Blue Holes Fish Habitat Protection Area Order 2007*.

2. Definitions

In this order the “waters of the Kalbarri Blue Holes” means all those waters bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the high water mark on the coastline and 27° 43.308’ south latitude; thence west by north along the geodesic to the intersection of 27° 43.243’ south latitude and 114° 09.137’ east longitude; thence north north easterly along the geodesic to the intersection of 27° 43.019’ south latitude and 114° 09.214’ east longitude; thence east south east along the geodesic to the intersection of the high water mark on the coast line and 27° 43.056’ south latitude; thence generally south south westerly along the high water mark to the commencement point.

3. Area of waters set aside as a fish habitat protection area

The waters of the Kalbarri Blue Holes are set aside as a fish habitat protection area.

4. Purposes for which area is set aside

The purposes for which the waters of the Kalbarri Blue Holes are set aside as a fish habitat protection area are the -

- (a) conservation and protection of fish, fish breeding areas, fish fossils and the aquatic eco-system; and
- (b) management of fish and activities relating to the appreciation and observation of fish.
