Context

- The Indicative Facility Class and RCM Facility Class Assessment WEMP was originally published 1 August 2021
- Further changes made in the Tranche 5 amendments resulted in minor changes to be published by **1 March 2022**
- Changes relate to specific requirements for new facilities entering into a Non-Co-optimised Essential System Service (NCESS) Contract.

Feedback and AEMO's response

Summary of comment	AEMO's response
Structural changes were proposed to paragraph 2.1.1 and 2.1.2 which cover the modification of Reserve Capacity timeframes.	AEMO agreed to changes proposed: 2.1.1 – covers all powers under the WEM Rules which enable AEMO to amend the dates and times of the Reserve Capacity timetable. 2.1.2 – covers AEMOs obligation to publish updated timetables following an extension under paragraph 2.1.1.
A number of minor grammatical, formatting and structural changes were proposed.	AEMO appreciates all feedback and considers changes on a case-by-case basis. All submissions and AEMOs responses will be published by 1 March 2022 (location TBD).
