What is the Aboriginal Mediation Services?

The Aboriginal Mediation Service (AMS) assist Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to resolve conflicts before they escalate into violence or result in court action.



What is mediation?

Mediation is a process where you sit with an accredited mediator and the people you are in dispute with to resolve your issues.
