## Engagement summary

### Reach

- 216 participants in metropolitan and regional Aboriginal community engagement workshops
- Over 150 key stakeholders engaged
- Over 130 responses received to an online survey for Aboriginal staff from the Department of Communities
- Aboriginal community engagement held across **Goldfields, Pilbara, Midwest-Gascoyne, Wheatbelt, Kimberley, Southwest** and **Perth metropolitan** regions
- Briefings with** Aboriginal Advisory Council of WA, Aboriginal Health Council of WA and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Social Justice Commissioner
- 99 online survey responses to the consultation draft Strategy
- Targeted **webinars, meetings, phone calls** and **emails** with over 200 community members and stakeholders to share and seek feedback on the consultation draft Strategy

Our engagement builds on what we heard during previous consultation processes prior to 2021, including the Aboriginal Family Safety Summit, development of Path to Safety and the Aboriginal Cultural Capability Reform Program.
