



Rule Change Extension Notice:

Method used for the assignment of Certified Reserve Capacity to Intermittent Generators (RC_2019_03)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the Market Rules.

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the WEM Rules, the Coordinator of Energy (**Coordinator**) has extended the timeframe for the publication of the Draft Rule Change Report for the Rule Change Proposal titled "Method used for the assignment of Certified Reserve Capacity to Intermittent Generators" (RC_2019_03) until **5:00 PM on 30 September 2023**.

Dates for subsequent steps of the rule change process have been adjusted accordingly.

Reason for the Extension

The Coordinator is currently conducting a review of the Reserve Capacity Mechanism (**RCM**)¹ which will (among other things) address the matters considered by RC_2019_03.

The RCM Review is expected to be completed by mid-2023, and the Minister for Energy is expected to subsequently make rule changes to give effect to the outcomes of the review.

Therefore, the Coordinator has extended the timeframe for publication of the Draft Rule Change Report for RC_2019_03 until 30 September 2023 to allow adequate time for the completion of the RCM Review.
