Member roles and responsibilities – Draft Code of Conduct

The Committee is forwarding its draft Code of Conduct to the Public Sector Commission for review prior to the Committee's final approval.

Presentation: Measuring on-road Vehicle Emissions with Remote Sensing in Australia

The Queensland Department of Environment and Science provided an overview of the study's methodology and findings. The study showed that real-world vehicle emission measurements are vital for understanding motor vehicle emissions impacts on public health and that consistent and uniform measurements of on-road vehicle emissions are required in all states and territories.

The recent work undertaken by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation on the Perth Air Emissions Study 2011-12 was cited as key to understanding the most significant emissions in the Perth air shed.

Air Quality Management Plan Reporting

Members discussed the reporting format and improvements that can be made to ensure additional information on reported air quality actions is easily accessible.
