1 How to avoid mould



Increase airflow



Turn on fans



Open doors/
windows



Limit condensation



Wipe condensation
(water or dampness)



Aircon at
24 degrees



Allow sunlight



Open blinds and curtains



Bin mouldy items



Place all mouldy
items in bin



Throw away all
wet items in bin

2 Cleaning simple mould




Cleaning instructions:



Step 1 →
Glasses, mask
and gloves on



Step 2 →
Spray mould



Step 3 →
Scrub mould



Step 4 →
Rinse brush



Step 5 →
Wipe away
mould



Step 6
Put all used rags
in bin

3 Dealing with complex mould

If there is still lots of mould even after cleaning three times or more do not try to clean the mould again




