10 TIPS FOR PERSONAL ACTION ON LITTER

Everyone can make a difference. This year, decide to do your bit for the environment and a litter-free WA. Change your thinking from "Someone else will do it" to "I can do that" and take action on litter today!

- Don't leave it to someone else!
 Carry a litter bag when out for a walk and pick up litter instead of leaving it in the streets or gutters.
- Never hose litter, leaves or debris down into gutters and drains as it finally ends up polluting our natural waterways through the storm water system. Use a broom to sweep paved areas instead.
- 3. When out and about, make sure your waste goes in to a public bin and not beside it. Alternatively, take your litter home, especially when visiting parks and gardens. Wind and animals scavenging in bins can often inadvertently create litter. Carry a litterbag in your car for collecting rubbish.
- 4. Refuse plastic bags when you are shopping. Plastic bags are a common litter item that are dangerous to marine animals. The animals can mistake the bags for jellyfish and eat them, often resulting in death.
- 5. Make sure your waste is secure in your bin or recycling container so that it cannot blow away and be washed into the storm water system.
- **6. Dispose of cigarette butts** either in a bin, public butt bins or carry your own personal ashtray. Personal ashtrays are available from KAB WA.
- **7. Pack a rubbish-free lunch** with reusable plastic containers and water bottles rather than bags and drink boxes.

- 8. Put a 'no junk mail' sign on your mailbox.
- **9. Secure your load** when transporting any materials to ensure that they don't fly off.
- 10. Never leave items beside charity bins.

 Dumped items are litter! Charities are forced to spend hundreds of thousands of dollars per year cleaning up litter dumped at charity bins.

MORE ACTION ON LITTER

- Become a litter reporter. KAB WA has a litter reporter scheme where litter related to vehicles can be reported. Call 6467 5129 and register.
- Adopt-a-Spot to keep litter-free in your neighbourhood.
- Report abandoned shopping trolleys. In Western Australia, Woolworths, Big W and Target are part of the Trolley Tracker scheme. When you report you go in the draw for a \$1,000 shopping card. Call 1800 641 497 or visit www.trolleytracker.com.au.
