Vickie the voyager's phishing facts

- 1. Urgency alert:**
Phishing emails create false urgency; pause and verify the sender's legitimacy.
- 2. Unknown sources:**
Be cautious with unexpected emails. If unsure, then report it to IT.
- 3. Personal info requests:**
Beware of unprompted requests; never share sensitive info via email.
- 4. Too good to be true:**
Remain sceptical of incredible offers. Always do your research.
- 5. Inconsistent language:**
Watch for errors! Legitimate emails maintain professionalism.
- 6. Avoid unexpected attachments:**
If in doubt, contact the sender through other means of communication.
- 7. Unprofessional design:**
Look out for poorly designed emails; spelling and grammar is important in professional emails.
