The preferred provider panel lists

Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) who are contracted by the Department of Training and Workforce Development to deliver funded vocation education and training in Western Australia are registered on preferred provider panels for the program(s) they successfully applied for and have a current year contract for.

At no cost, contracted RTOs can advertise through the Department the qualifications they are contracted to deliver under the programs on preferred provider panel lists. RTOs delivering in more than one program can advertise on more than one preferred provider panel list.

Preferred provider panel lists are advertised to the public on the Departments Jobs and Skills WA website and are available on the Department's website. https://www.dtwd.wa.gov.au/





To advertise on a preferred provider panel list for the above programs you must have an active CPS for the current year. Please register a contact person for the advertisement with the Department.



To register a contact person you must;


- I. Access TAMS RTO Portal on https://tamsrtoportal.dtwd.wa.gov.au/
- II. Select 'My details' in the tabs and open 'Contact Details'




III. Select 'Edit' for an existing contact




IV. Select 'Add Role' under Preferred Provider List Roles

VI. Select 'Add'




TRAINEESHIPS

To advertise on the preferred provider panel for the traineeships program, training providers must complete two stages;

- 1) Have an active Traineeship CPS for the current year.
- 2) Nominate the qualification(s) and region(s) you would like to advertise delivery in;

To nominate a qualification and region you must;

- I. Access TAMS RTO Portal on https://tamsrtoportal.dtwd.wa.gov.au/
- II. Select 'Contracts' in the tabs and open 'Preferred Provider List'



III. A list of your qualifications on scope will appear by year and program.




V. Select 'Add Region' and select the region(s) you would like to advertise for delivering the qualification

To remove all/some qualification(s) from the preferred provider panel lists for these programs you must submit a request to your contract case manager at the Department via email at training.markets@dtwd.wa.gov.au

TRAINEESHIPS

To remove all/some qualification(s) from the traineeship preferred provider panel list you must open each individual qualification in the contracted provider list on TAMS RTO Portal and the regions you no longer wish to advertise delivery in. To remove the qualification entirely you must submit a request to your contract case manager at the Department via email at training.markets@dtwd.wa.gov.au

Important note: The preferred provider panel lists are updated nightly. Any changes you make will not appear until the next day.
