Prescribed plastic items	Specified exempt circumstance	Exemption reason
Takeaway food containers and takeaway food container lids	This class exemption is for the sale or supply of food containers and their lids and is only applicable for takeaway food uses when the container is holding soupy or liquid foods that can be poured and are served at over 60 degrees Celsius.	Currently there are limited food packaging options available that meet safe food handling requirements, reduce risks of leaking and provide an effective barrier for prolonged storage.

### Interpretation

#### In this Exemption Notice:

- (a) the words 'including', 'includes' and 'include' in conditions mean "including but not limited to", and similar, as appropriate;
- (b) where any word or phrase is given a defined meaning, any other part of speech or other grammatical form of that word or phrase has a corresponding meaning;
- (c) unless specified otherwise, any reference to a section of an Act refers to that section of the EP Act; and
- (d) unless specified otherwise, all definitions are in accordance with the EP Act.

#### **Conditions**

#### **Conditions of supply**

- 1. The Exemption Holder may supply the prescribed plastic items listed in Table 1 of this Exemption Notice in the specified exempt circumstance and for the corresponding exemption reason only.
- 2. Before 30 August 2024, or within 30 days of adding a product under this exemption, the Exemption Holder, or someone using this exemption, must provide the following information to the CEO:
  - (a) Business name;
  - (b) Details of authorised representative;
  - (c) List of items supplied under this exemption

#### Non-compliance reporting

- 3. Within 14 business days of becoming aware of any non-compliance with the conditions of this Exemption Notice, the Exemption Holder must notify the CEO in writing of that non-compliance and include in that notification the following information:
  - (a) which condition was not complied with;
  - (b) the time and date when the non-compliance occurred;
  - (c) the details and result of any investigation undertaken into the cause of the non-compliance;
  - (d) what action has been taken and the date on which it was taken to prevent the non-compliance occurring again; and
  - (e) what action will be taken and the date by which it will be taken to prevent the non-compliance occurring again.

#### **Revocation or Variation**

4. In accordance with regulation 20(5) of the regulations this exemption notice may be revoked or varied by the CEO or a Delegated Officer at any time by written notice.
