FISHERIES ACT 1905

Notice No. 234

F & W 171/82.

PURSUANT to the powers conferred by sections 9 and 11 of the Act, I hereby declare that the taking of all gastropod molluscs (class gastropoda) (eg. conch shells, baler shells, spider shells, volutes etc) by any means of capture in the waters specified in the Schedule hereto is prohibited.

Fisheries Notice No. 185 published in the *Government Gazette* on 24 May 1985 is hereby cancelled.

Schedule

All that portion of water surrounding Gantheaume Point bounded by a line commencing at a point on the high water mark due west of Saddle Hill; thence due west to a point due north of the western extremity of Gantheaume Point; thence southwesterly to a point 1500 metres due west of Gantheaume Point; thence southeasterly to a point 1500 metres due west of the southernmost point of Riddell Point; thence due east to the high water mark; thence northerly along the high water mark to the starting point.
