FISHERIES ACT 1905.

Notice No. 194.

F.D. 858/72.

PURSUANT to sections 9 and 11 of the Act I hereby prohibit licensed professional fishermen other than those with written approval of the Director of Fisheries from taking or attempting to take mud crabs (*Scylla spp*) in Western Australian waters specified in Schedules 1 and 2.

Notice No. 180 published in the *Government Gazette* of 26 April 1985 is hereby cancelled.

Schedule 1.

All waters within 500m of any mangrove stand between Christine Point located north of Derby and the point known locally as Escape Point, located south of Derby.

Schedule 2.

All waters of every tidal creek and pool contiguous to King Sound between Christine Point located North of Derby and the point known locally as Escape Point located South of Derby.
