ACTING in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12A of the Act, I hereby declare the area set out in the Schedule below to be a Proclaimed Fishing Zone from 15 February to 30 April inclusive in each and every year.

Fisheries Notice No. 130 in respect of Nanarup Beach published in the Government Gazette of 3 June 1983 is hereby cancelled.

Nanarup Beach.

All that portion of water bounded by lines commencing at the intersection of the prolongation southerly of the easternmost boundary of Part A/82 of Plantagenet Location 416 with the High Water Mark and extending generally southwesterly along the High Water Mark to Islet Point thence southeast 800 metres thence generally northeasterly to a point 800 metres south of the starting point thence north to the starting point.
