FISHERIES ACT 1905 – 1975  
(Sections 9 and 11.)

Notice

F. & W. 673/74.

THE Minister for Fisheries and Wildlife, acting in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Fisheries Act hereby prohibits the taking of fish by means of set nets in the waters specified in the schedule hereto excepting that licensed professional fishermen may –

- (a) take crabs by means of set nets with a mesh size of not less than 127 millimetres and not greater than seven meshes in depth; and
- (b) take shark by means of set nets with a mesh size of not less than 152 millimetres.

The waters of the Indian Ocean commencing at a point on the foreshore situate in prolongation westerly of the southern boundary of the Town of Cockburn and extending southerly to Cape Bouvard south of Mandurah, with a width seawards of 800 metres from high water mark.
