

FISHERIES ACT 1905
Notice No. 366

392/87.

PURSUANT to sections 9 and 11 of the Act I hereby prohibit all licensed professional fishermen from taking any of the fish specified in the schedule in all Western Australian waters at all times unless the person is the holder of a licence authorising him to do so.

Fisheries Notice No. 291, published in Government Gazette No. 79 of 19 August 1988, is hereby cancelled.

Schedule

1. All fish of the class *Gastropoda* (includes whelks, limpets, turban shells, top shells, periwinkles, balers, giant conch shells and trochus shells).
2. All fish of the class *Lamellibranchiata* (bivalves – includes cockles, mussels and razor shells).
3. All fish of the classes *Echinoidea* and *Asteroidea* (includes sea urchins and starfish).
4. All fish of the class *Holothuroidea* (Beche de Mer – also called sea cucumber or trepang).
