

FISHERIES ACT 1905

Notice No. 419

232/70, Vol. 2.

PURSUANT to sections 9 and 10 of the Act I hereby prohibit –

- (a) the class of persons specified in Schedule 1 from taking fish by any means in the waters described in Schedule 3; and
- (b) the taking of fish by persons other than those specified in Schedule 1 by means other than the means specified in Schedule 2 in the waters described in Schedule 3.

Schedule 1

Class of Persons

The holder of a Professional Fisherman's Licence.

Schedule 2

Permitted Means of Taking Fish

1. Handline.
2. Rod and line.

Schedule 3

Description of Waters

All waters within a radius of 350 metres of the spar buoy anchored on the Quindalup artificial reef in Geographe Bay.
