Government Heritage Property Disposal Process P27311 Reids Ridge Abandoned Mine Site

Thank you for referring *Reids Ridge Abandoned Mine Site* on behalf of the Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety to the Department of Planning, Lands, and Heritage under the provisions of the Government Heritage Property Disposal Process (GPHDP).

As the delegate of the Heritage Council, I consider that while *Reids Ridge Abandoned Mine Site* has heritage value, it is unlikely to have the cultural heritage significance required to meet the condition for entry in the State Register and therefore does not warrant a full assessment. A copy of the preliminary review is enclosed for your information.

No further referrals under the Government Heritage Property Disposal Process are required on the part of the Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety in terms of disposing of this place.

Stuart Smith, Director General, Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions has been informed of this decision.

The Shire of Yalgoo has also been informed of this decision and provided with a copy of the preliminary review for consideration in terms of its Local Government Heritage Survey and any Heritage List associated with its planning scheme.
