The Awards have eight individual categories, and five organisation categories.

In addition to the recognition and opportunities these prestigious awards bring, winners in individual categories will receive \$3,000.

Organisation winners are recognised as industry leaders and promoted and celebrated through a variety of media and marketing opportunities.

Winners of selected categories* may have the opportunity to represent WA and be acknowledged nationally at the Australian Training Awards (ATAs). State winners attend the ATAs finalists' week and presentation ceremony, where the national winners for each category are announced.
