

## DEMIRS Occupational Licensing Performance Report December Quarter 2024

In this quarter, DEMIRS finalised 43,111 applications with overall performance remaining steady.

The Building Practitioner and Building Contractor categories showed strong performance, with 79 per cent of applications finalised within the target timeframe, up from 77 per cent. Average processing times also improved significantly, reducing to 25 days.

Painting licensing continued to improve, with 95 per cent of applications completed within target, up from 92 per cent. Building Surveyors saw a decline in performance, dropping from 87 per cent to 72 per cent completed within target. This decline was primarily due to a significant increase in applications, with 201 applications finalised this quarter, representing a 109 per cent increase from the previous quarter.

Performance for Owner Builders remained strong, with 99 per cent of applications finalised within target and average processing times reducing from 36 days to 34. Plumbing licences also demonstrated significant improvement, with 55 per cent finalised within the target timeframe, up from 32 per cent. Processing times also improved from 15 days to 11. Similarly, Gas licences showed improvement, with 56 per cent finalised within target, up from 43 per cent and processing times improving from 14 days to 10. Performance in the Electrical licensing category showed a slight decline, with 71 per cent finalised within target, down from 75 per cent. Dangerous Goods Driver and Shotfiring licences saw a decline in performance, with 71 per cent finalised within target, down from 88 per cent.

Motor Vehicle industry experienced a decline in performance, with 29 per cent finalised within the target timeframe and an average processing time of 16 business days. Property industry licensing also saw a decline, with only 16 per cent finalised within the target timeframe and an average processing time of 15 business days. Each of these is now subject to remediation efforts and expected to improve in the next quarter.


High Risk Work licences experienced a slight decline, with 34 per cent of applications finalised within target, down from 38 per cent, however at the same time, processing timeframes improved from 31 business days to 20.


## Distribution of business days to finalise applications - 2024 Q4
